- 1. Date of Retirement
- 2. Effective Years of Service
- 3. Initial Retirement Pay Entitlement
- 4. Total Amount Commuted
- 5. Initial Gross Reduced Rate of Retirement Pay

Don't forget to quote your DFRDB account number, which will be; ( $\underline{N}avy/\underline{A}rmy/\underline{R}AAF$ ) + Service Number + DF, for example; A1234567DF.
